



Pretty waves of eyelets and textures are achieved with 4 simple pattern rows. The repeat combines 3 fast rows, which are all knit or purl, with 1 row of eyelets. The garter stitch neck edging is knit as you work to speed up finishing.

- 4/5 Extra-Large** 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust

- Extra-Small/Small** 35½" [96.5 cm]
- Medium/Large** 44" [112 cm]
- Extra-Large** 48½" [127 cm]
- 2/3 Extra-Large** 57½" [146 cm]
- 4/5 Extra-Large** 65" [165 cm]

MATERIALS

Patons® Silk Bamboo™

(65 g/2.2 oz; 93 m/102 yds)

Sizes XS/S M XL 2/3XL 4/5XL
 Moss (85236) 8 9 10 12 14 balls

Sizes 3.5 mm (U.S. 4) and 4 mm (U.S. 6) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension**. 2 stitch markers.

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

STITCH GLOSSARY

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

BACK

***With smaller needles cast on **98** (122-134-158-182) sts.
 Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

- 1st row:** (RS). Knit.
 - 2nd row:** Purl.
 - 3rd row:** K1. (K2tog) twice. *(yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) 4 times. Rep from * to last 9 sts. (yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) twice. K1.
 - 4th row:** Knit.
- These 4 rows form Feather and Fan Pat.**

Note: When determining lengths, allow piece to hang while measuring.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx **22** (22-23-23-23)" [**56** (56-58.5-58.5-58.5) cm], ending with a 4th row of pat.

*****Place pat for neck shaping: 1st row:** (RS). Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts. K**46** (46-58-58-58) sts. Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts. Rep last row 8 times more [keeping center **46** (46-58-58-58) sts in garter st].

Shape neck: Next row: (WS). Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts. K4. Cast off center **38** (38-50-50) sts. K4 (including st on needle after cast off). Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts.

Cont in pat on last **26** (38-38-50-62) sts, AT SAME TIME, working garter st across 4 sts at neck edge until work from beg measures

25 (25-26-26-26)" [**63.5** (63.5-66-66-66) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **10** (14-14-18-22) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **10** (14-14-18-22) sts.

With RS facing, join yarn to rem sts. K4. Pat **26** (38-38-50-62) sts.

Cont in pat on **26** (38-38-50-62) sts, AT SAME TIME, working garter st across 4 sts at neck edge until work from beg measures **25** (25-26-26-26)" [**63.5** (63.5-66-66-66) cm], ending with a RS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **10** (14-14-18-22) sts beg next and following alt row. Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off rem **10** (14-14-18-22) sts.***

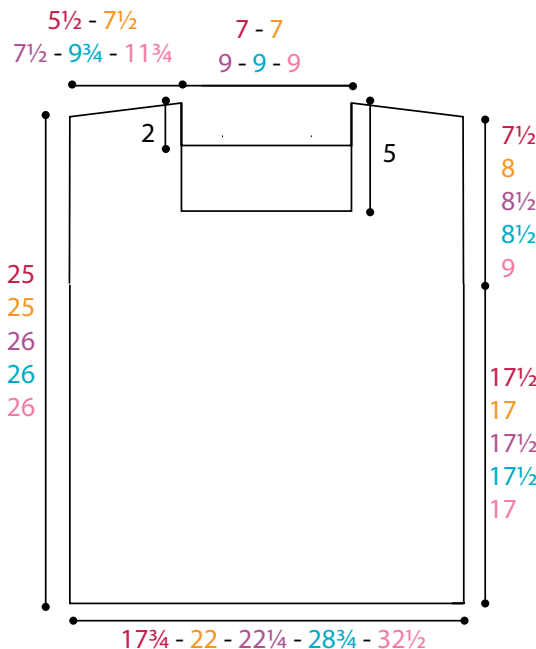
FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.
 Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx **19** (19-20-20-20)" [**48** (48-51-51-51) cm], ending with a 4th row of pat.
 Work from *** to *** as given for Back.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Place markers on side edges **7½** (8-8½-8½-9)" [**19** (20.5-21.5-21.5-23) cm] down from shoulder seams.

Armbands: With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit **77** (81-85-85-89) sts evenly between markers. Knit 7 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS). Sew side and armband seams.



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
