



MATERIALS

Bernat® Satin™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 200 yds/182 m)
Aqua (04201)

You can make 9 Coin Purses with 1 ball of yarn.

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 2 buttons.
2 Stitch Markers.

ABBREVIATIONS: www.yarnspirations.com/abbreviations

Beg = Beginning

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2
stitches together

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yo = Yarn over



MEASUREMENTS

4" [10 cm] wide x 2½" [6 cm] high.

GAUGE

19 sts and 25 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking
st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 19 sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last
st. K1.

Rep last row of Seed St Pat until work
from beg measures 5¼" [13 cm], ending
with a RS row. Place marker at each end
of last row.

Work 3 rows in pat.

Next row: (RS). (Buttonhole row). (K1. P1)
twice. yo. K2tog. (K1. P1) 3 times. K1. yo.
K2tog. (P1. K1) twice.

Work 2 rows in pat. Cast off.

Finishing

Fold work, matching cast on edge with
marked row. Sew side seams. Attach
buttons to correspond to buttonholes.
